YEAR 1 TOPIC WEB TERMS 1 & 2: To Infinity and Beyond!

Reading

Phonics will remain a focus throughout the year. Reading will continue to take place daily. Four Read Write Inc. sessions a week will be dedicated to phonics. fluency and comprehension and one session a week will aim to develop a love of reading through 'Stop, Drop and Read.'

Writing

Using our quality key texts, Year 1 will begin to develop their understanding of sentence writing. We will be learning to use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces to write sentences for a range of purposes. The children will be encouraged to use their phonics to spell whilst building up a repertoire of common exception words.

Mathematics

During Term 1 and 2, the children will spend time deepening their understanding of '10.' We'll be learning to find one more and one less, to compare and order numbers and to add numbers within 10. Using concrete resources, Year 1 will explore finding number bonds to 10 and will begin to recall these mentally.

Art & DT

In Art, we will be studying the work

of Andy Warhol. After exploring

the use of lines, shapes and

colours, the children will draw a

toy in the style of Warhol's pop art.

In DT, Year 1 will be designing and

making a home for superhero of

Science

During Term 1 and 2, Year 1 will be observing and describing seasonal changes. We will look for signs of autumn and winter and will be learning to measure different weathers. The children will have the opportunity to make their own rain gauge and to measure the temperature.



Year 1 will have PE twice a week on

the Brighton and Hove Sports

Coaches, the children will be

exploring football and hockey. With

their class teacher, the children will

be developing 'multi-skills' and will

explore different styles of dance.

History

In History, we will be exploring changes within living memory by looking at the evolution of toys. The children will have a chance to handle toys from the past to compare them to modern day toys. We will also learn about Louis Braille and how he changed the world of books forever.

In Term 2, Year 1 will be studying maps to learn about human and physical features using The Hundred Decker Bus book. Once the children have identified different places and areas on a variety of maps, they will draw their own map using symbols to show the human and physical features.

Geography

MFL

Modern Foreign Languages are so important when living in such a diverse world. We will begin the year by revising the French taught in EYFS. Once we have recapped counting to 10, we will be learning to name colours in French.

PSHE and Computing

In PSHE, we will be focusing on 'being me' and will be learning to celebrate differences. During these lessons, we will be exploring 'feeling proud' as well as rewards, consequences, bullying and friendship. In computing the students will be looking at the different parts of a computer as well as starting to give complex instructions to robots.


RE
